Children and Worship: Children are welcome to join us for worship.

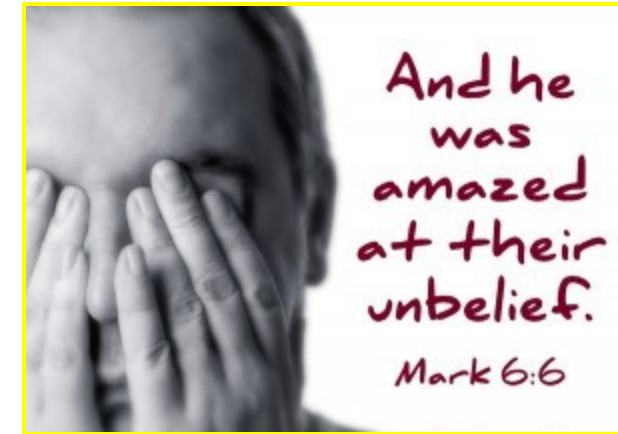
Nursery care is available in room 102 for children ages 4 and younger.
