Lighting the Advent Candles Blackmon and Black Families

On this second Sunday of Advent, we light the candle of peace.  
Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God."  
Christ comes as God with us to bring us peace in this life and the promise of everlasting  
life. We light the candle of peace to remind us that Jesus is the Prince of Peace and that  
through him real peace is found.  
Today we reflect on the image of God as our Shepherd. Isaiah writes,  
**He tends his flock like a shepherd: He gathers the lambs in his arms and carries them  
close to his heart; he gently leads those that have young.**  
Jesus said, "I am the Good Shepherd." As we light the candle of peace, we celebrate the  
peace we find in Jesus Christ.  
**Our peace is in God, Our Shepherd.**
