### **Expectations:**

Campers are expected to be well behaved, respectful, and cooperative. Campers should be responsible during free time, follow camp guidelines, and be on time to camp activities.

### **Checklist:**

- Fill out a registration form and include your payment of \$140 or \$155.
- If applying for a need-based scholarship, turn in a scholarship application and payment.
- Make sure you have an FBCP 2018 Child Medical and Permission Form on file with a copy of your health insurance card.
- Fill out a Bonclarken Release Form.
- Attend Camper and Parent Meeting (time TBA).
- Participate in Dessert Auction fundraiser on May 30th.** Campers are encouraged to come to dinner that Wednesday night with a baked good to auction.
- Meet at the church to leave for camp July 10<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am.**
- Campers will return Friday, July 13th around 3:00 pm.

## What to bring:

- ❑ old comfortable clothing for 3 days
- ❑ **tennis shoes** (some activities require closed toed tennis shoes)
- ❑ rain gear and light jacket
- ❑ swimsuit, beach towel, and flip flops
- ❑ bath towel and washcloth
- ❑ watch (campers are responsible for being on time to all activities)
- ❑ Linens: twin sheets or a sleeping bag
- ❑ Toiletries: Shampoo, soap, **sunscreen**, and deodorant
- ❑ Bible and pen
- ❑ Small amount of money for Mission Offering, Nibble Nook and Gift Shop (no more than \$20). Campers are responsible for keeping up with their money.
