Directions to Church Picnic

- —Coming from Pendleton on Highway 76 towards Clemson, turn LEFT on Woodburn Rd at the light in front of Tri County Tech (½ mile past the red light in front of BiLo)
- —After 2 ½ miles, you will see Fants Grove Baptist Church on your right.
- —Go straight at the stop sign. At the next stop sign (only about 100 yards later) the road dead ends; turn LEFT.
- —This is Twin Lakes Drive but there is no road sign. Stay on this road for 1 mile, following the signs to the picnic area.
- —Immediately after the parking attendant booth, turn RIGHT, and follow that road ½ mile to shelter # 2 on your left with the lake on your right.
