Preparing for Worship

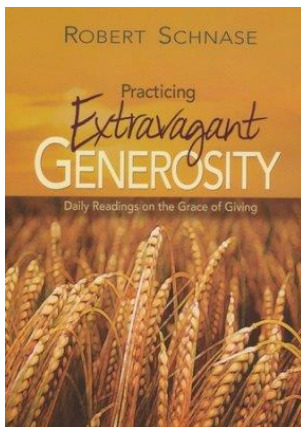
Children and Worship: Children are welcome to join us for worship.
