Nursery care is available in room 102 for children ages 4 and younger.

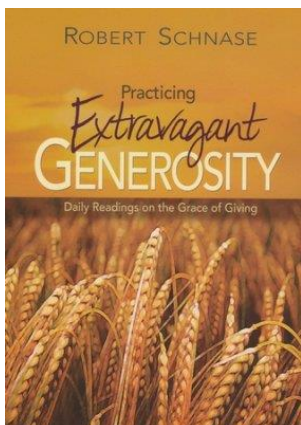
A Time for Children occurs during the worship service for children of all ages.
