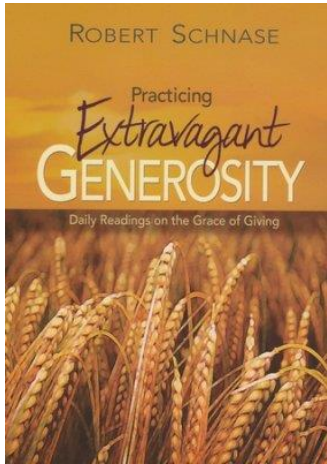
Meditation

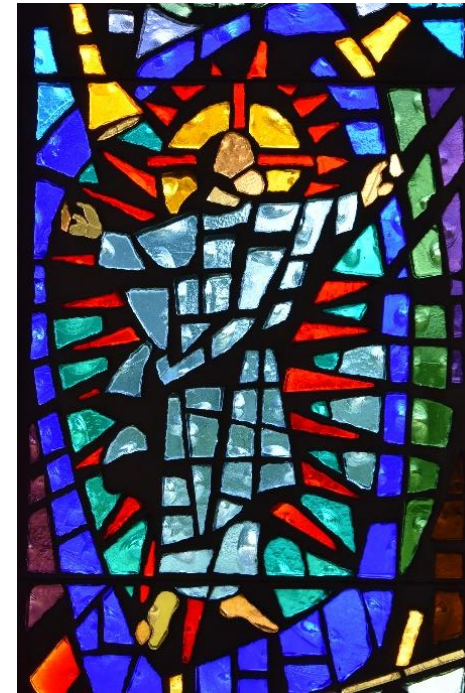
