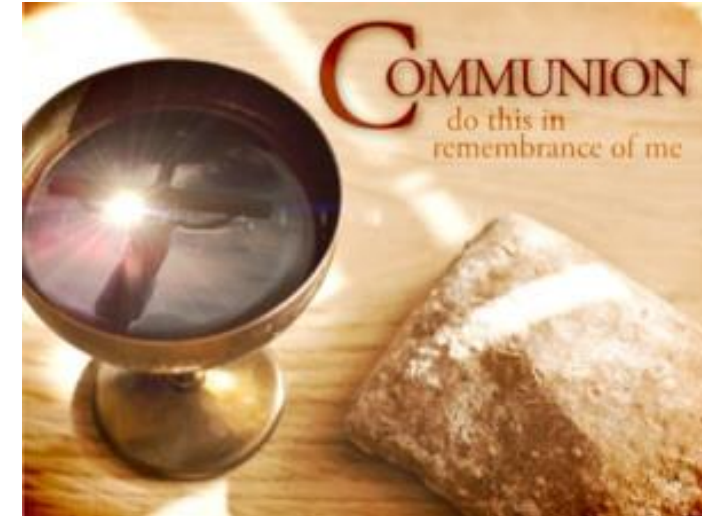
Meditation
