The flowers this week are a gift of David and Gail Wolgamott, in honor of their sixth anniversary on October 2.

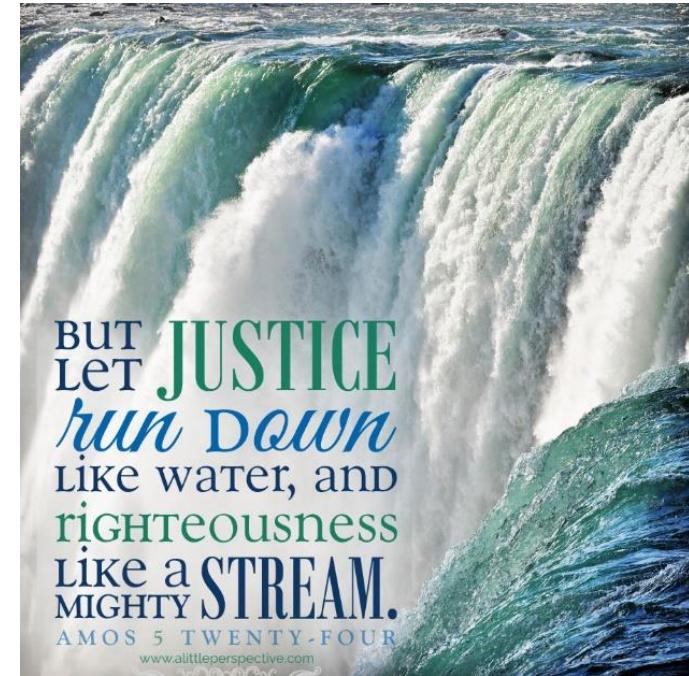
Children and Worship: Children are welcome to join us for worship.
