In John 21, on the beach after Jesus' resurrection, Jesus tells Peter, "feed my sheep." Peter has just netted a miraculous catch of fish. Jesus had earlier told Peter he would fish for people. What does Peter know about being a shepherd?

On Sunday, May 1, we will delve into Peter's encounter with Jesus on the beach through a sermon entitled "From Catching Fish to Tending Sheep." Throughout the rest of May, we will explore **Shepherd Essentials**. What does Peter (and what do we) need to be a shepherd? Using passages from the gospel of John, we will discover the essentials for shepherding like Jesus: **Follow, Love, Believe, and Pray**.
