Update on Woodchuck Ministry

Woodchucks · Firewood Ministry · 2021/2022 Season

- Season ran from November 8, 2021 to April 9, 2022 (5 Months)
- 44 truckloads of firewood delivered to folks in need
- 10 different clients/families served
- 19 Workdays (Saturday mornings), Avg 4 hours per workday, Avg 8.89 volunteers per workday
- 676 Man Hours Total [19 x 4 x 8.89]
- approximately 34 truckloads stored to dry for next season



The Woodchucks Ministry cuts and delivers firewood for people in need, many of whom rely solely on wood fires for heating during the winter. Volunteers meet on Saturday mornings and will be starting the 2022-2023 season in the coming weeks. If you are interested in volunteering or if you know someone in need of firewood for heat, please contact the church office.
