



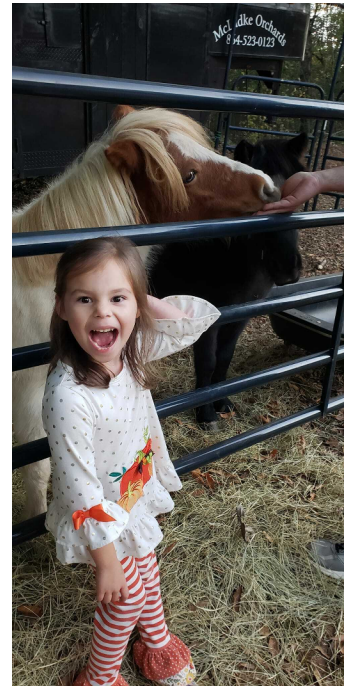
CBFSC Coordinator to Visit FBC Pendleton
