The Anderson Area Remembrance and Reconciliation Initiative (AAR&RI) commissioned a sculpture to honor the lives of the five known incidents of racial terror lynching in Anderson County, South Carolina, which occurred from the late 1800s to the early 1900s. AAR&RI partnered with designer and lead artist, Anderson native Herman Keith, Jr., to "take the story to the people" in a powerful way to educate, evoke empathy, and inspire movement toward a more just society.
