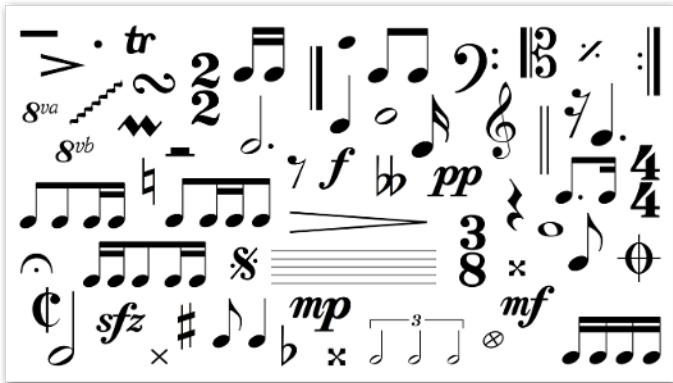
We truly can't do what we do without people like you. Your dedication makes all the difference, and I hope you know how much we appreciate it.

Senior Adult Ministry

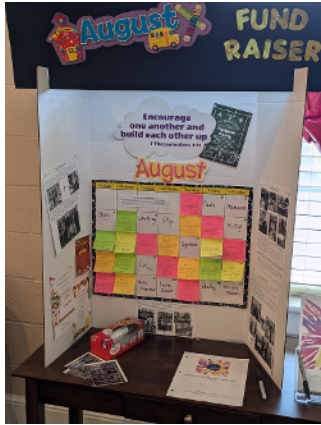
