Christmas Tea



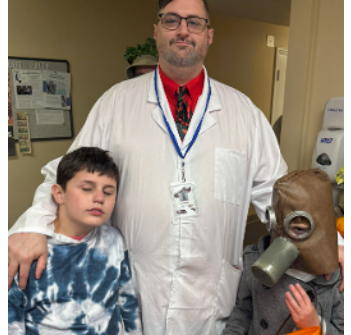
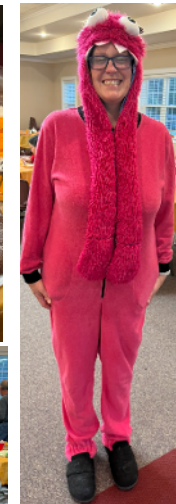
