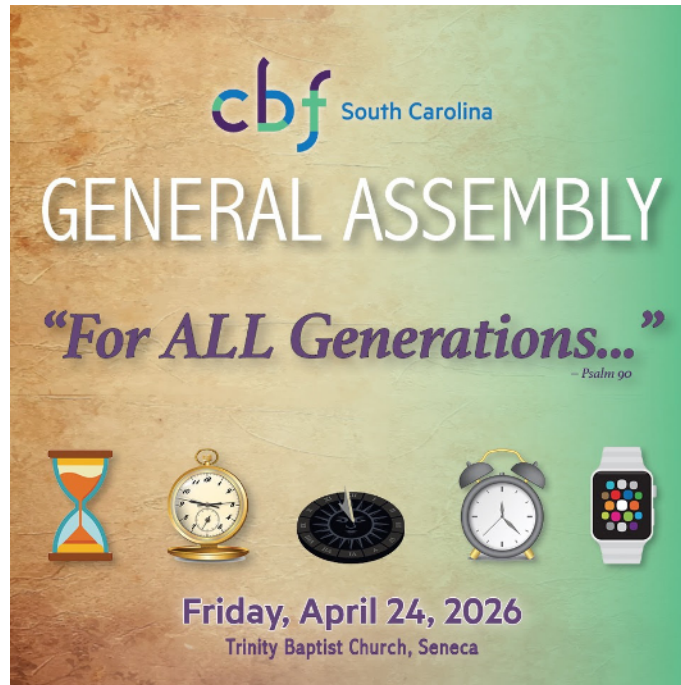

# Senior Adult Ministry

Senior Adult Ministry ended February with an engaging lecture from our FBCP office manager, Joe Reed, who spoke about two homes designed by American architect Frank Lloyd Wright.

**Fallingwater** is the mountain retreat built over Bear Run Creek in the Laurel Mountains of southwestern Pennsylvania for the Edgar J. Kaufmann family, who owned a department store in Pittsburgh. This iconic home appeared on the covers of Time magazine and Life magazine and is now a museum home and UNESCO World Heritage Site. The construction of this home sent Wright's career into the category of greatest American architect. The home's placement over the creek, the natural stone used, and the multiple cantilevered balconies, mimicking the flow of the stream, all facilitated the "organic architecture" of Wright. Fallingwater is now a museum home owned by the Western Pennsylvania Conservancy.



Just a few miles away is a "Grand Usonian" home, beautiful but far more modest than Fallingwater, designed by Wright for I.N. and Bernadette Hagan, who owned a dairy farm and ice cream company. The home was called **Kentuck Knob**, named after the mountaintop it is built on. The Hagans were friends of the Kaufmanns and were entertained at Fallingwater. A recurring theme in Wright's career is friends of clients falling in love with his work, and wanting a home designed by him, too. The Hagans moved into their home on their 26th wedding anniversary, and lived in the home for 30 years. Due to declining health, they sold their home to Lord Palumbo, of London, England, a real estate developer. The family now opens the home to the public for tours. The home has been well-maintained its entire life and is in excellent condition.
