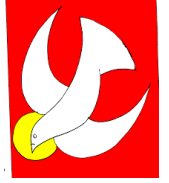
Happy Anniversary Don & Sue Baldwin

Senior Adult Ministry

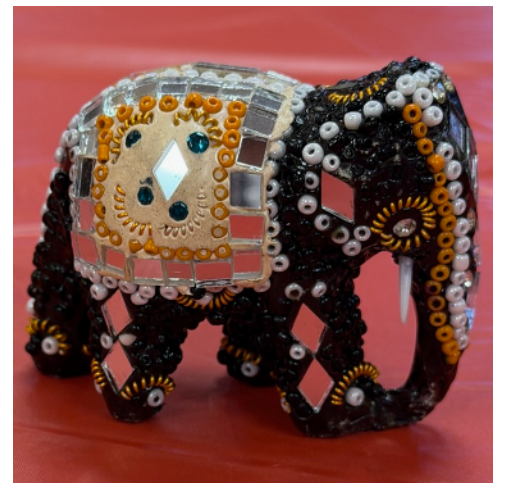
